OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of this activity, participants will be able to:

- Accurately diagnose and grade squamous dysplasia/carcinoma in the head and neck;
- Utilize and interpret appropriate ancillary immunohistochemical and/or molecular tests in diagnosis and prognosis of head and neck tumors;
- Recognize newly described or defined tumors of the head and neck region such as NUT midline carcinoma, SMARCB-1 deficient tumors and other carcinoma variants;
- Distinguish between benign neoplasms and low grade carcinomas, recognizing diagnostic pitfalls;
- Classify appropriate thyroid lesions as noninvasive follicular thyroid neoplasms with papillary-like nuclear features (NIFTP) and understand the implications of this new classification
